

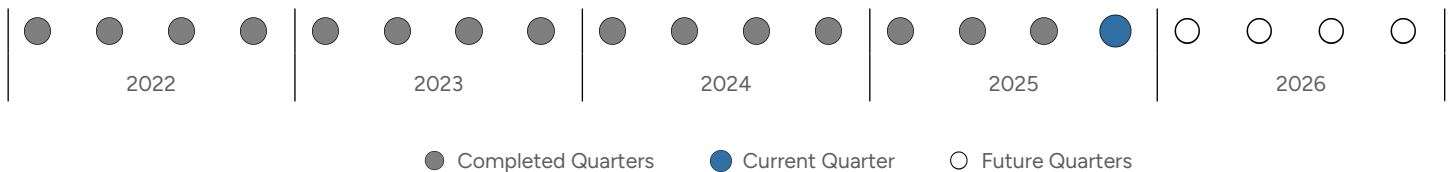

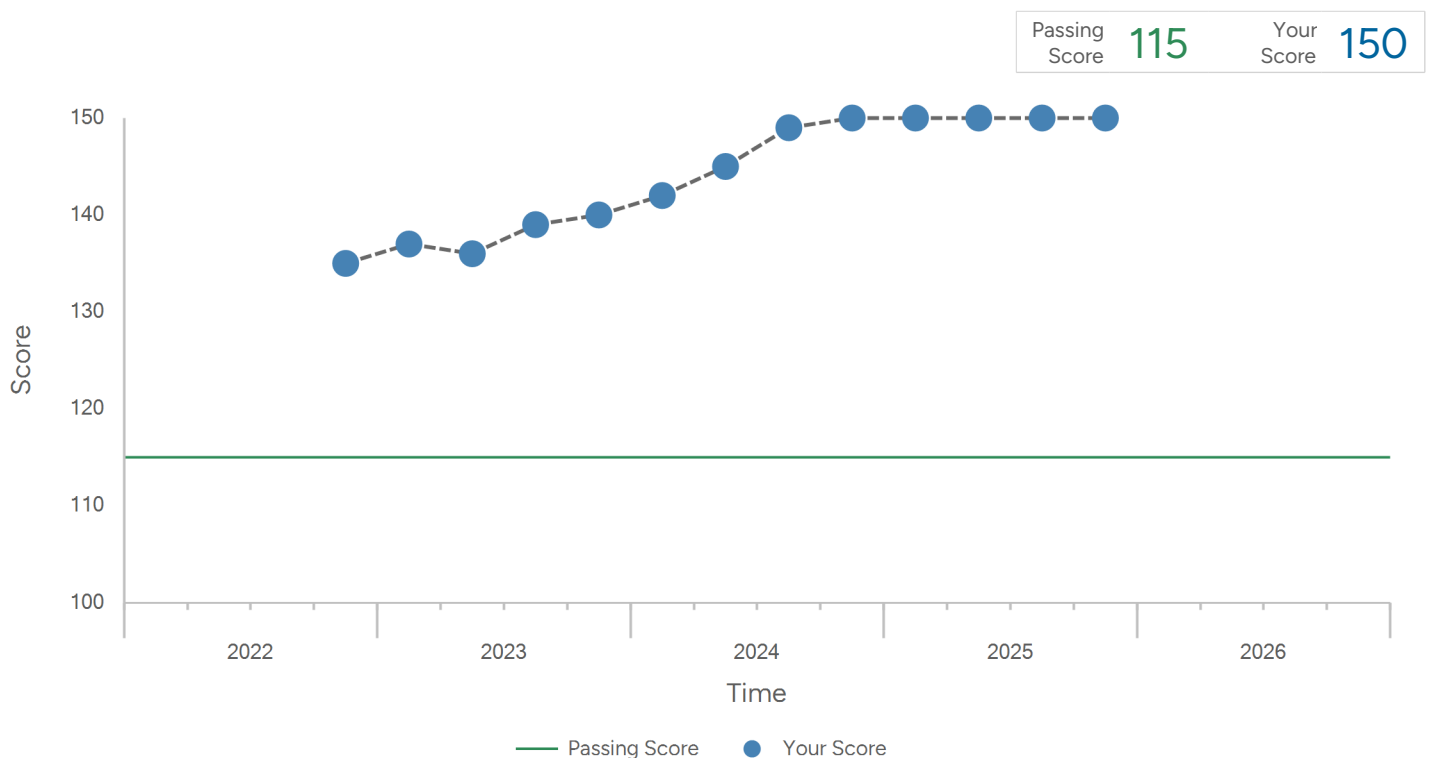


YOUR PERFORMANCE

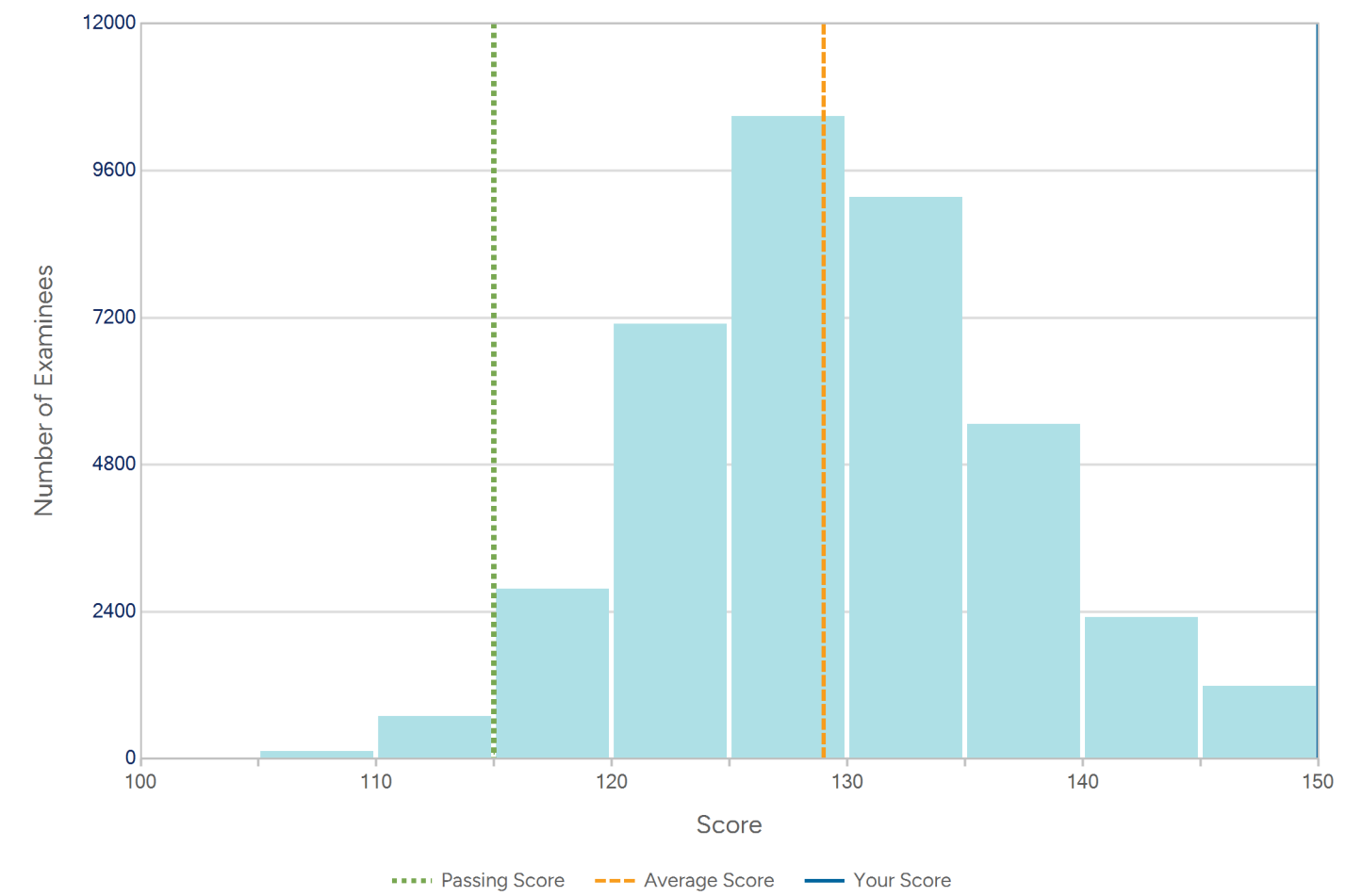
GROUP PERFORMANCE
